

Middle School Happenings

Last week we welcomed families into the Middle School to meet and greet their child's teachers. It was great to see new faces and have chats to parents in a casual atmosphere. The staff would like to thank those that made the effort to come in and take the time to get to know your child's teacher and see their learning space.

For those unable to attend feel free to drop in before or after school or make contact with your child's teacher to organize a suitable time.

Middle School Information for Parents:

Mobile Phones: Are NOT permitted in class during lesson time — it is expected that the students hand their phones up at the beginning of the day to be securely put away until breaks. Please ensure if your child brings a phone to school they follow the rules to make learning time as valuable as possible and not to be distracted by a message or call. We have had a few students going to the toilet to check their snap chat or messages and we really want to encourage this to only happen during recess and lunch. Last week some of our students were being silly with their phones and filming others in the yard in their uniform. This is totally unacceptable and if it continues those students will not be able to get their phones back until the end of the day.

Behaviour: Yellow cards are already in use as some students have forgotten how to behave at school. If a student is issued a yellow card the home group teacher will try to get in touch with the parent to let them know the reason for this. If the behvaiour of the child does not improve it may lead to suspension. The yellow cards have comments from each subject teacher for a week so that families can see what's happening throughout the week.

Uniform: Thank you to all the students wearing their correct uniforms. Please try to get your child into the right uniform for the day. Check your child's timetable to see when they have PE – the PE uniform is the yellow and green t-shirt with black or green bottoms. Boys have white shirts with grey shorts and girls should be wearing the summer dress.


NAPLAN


