
### **Scratch coding with Makey Makey**



# **BACON & VEGGIE NOODLE SLICE**



2 Teaspoons Vegetable Oil, 2 rashers bacon (chopped), 200g approx. hokkien noodles, 2 medium grated zucchinis, 2 medium grated carrots, 125g can corn kernels, 1/2 cup frozen peas, 4 spring onions (thinly sliced), 1 cup SR Flour, 1/2 grated cheese, 4 eggs, 1/2 cup milk, 1/4 cup Vegetable Oil.

Preheat oven to 180 degrees. Fry bacon until golden.

Combine all ingredients and mix well in a bowl then add to greased pan or dish.

Bake for 30 to 35 minutes or until golden and set.

This recipe is great for leftover school lunch and can be served cold or hot.
