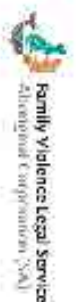

## THE ANXIETY CURVE; WHAT TO DO WHEN A PERSON ON THE AUTISM SPECTRUM IS ESCALATING

### IN FOCUS WORKSHOP



**TIME:** 1.30pm-4.30pm  
**DATE:** 5 July 2018  
**VENUE:** Crossways Lutheran School, 4 Smith Rd, Ceduna SA 5690

This workshop acknowledges that many individuals on the autism spectrum have high anxiety levels. This workshop will discuss the importance of identifying observable signs of anxiety at five different levels, and how a person can respond when an individual is at these different levels. The workshop will also discuss how staff can support/teach an individual to self-identify their anxiety level and use effective strategies to reduce it.

Topics include:

- What to do at each level when anxiety escalates;
- How to teach an individual to self-regulate;
- The importance of non-aversive behaviour management;
- How to teach an individual strategies to calm; and
- Developing a 5-Point Plan for support staff.

All participants will receive a certificate with the workshop title and the number of hours, stating that the workshop links to the Australian Professional Standards for Teachers.

**One Pot Sausage Casserole**



1 tablespoon olive oil, 500g sausages, 1 brown onion sliced, 2 cloves crushed garlic, 400g tin Cannellini beans rinsed & drained, 2 x 400g tins diced tomato, 1/4 cup BBQ sauce, 1 tablespoon brown sugar, chopped parsley leaves to serve, crusty bread to serve.

Brown sausages in pan with 1/2 the oil then remove. Heat remaining oil and add onion & garlic, cook until onion has softened. Add beans, tomato, BBQ sauce & sugar. Return sausages to pan, cover and bring to boil, reduce heat and simmer for 25 mins.
