

One Pot Sausage Casserole



tablespoon olive oil, 500g sausages, 1 brown onion sliced, 2 cloves crushed garlic, 400g tin Cannellini beans rinsed & drained, 2 x 400g tins diced tomato, 1/4 cup BBQ sauce,
tablespoon brown sugar, chopped parsley leaves to serve,

crusty bread to serve.

Brown sausages in pan with 1/2 the oil then remove. Heat remaining oil and add onion & garlic, cook until onion has softened. Add beans, tomato, BBQ sauce & sugar. Return sausages to pan, cover and bring to boil, reduce heat and simmer for 25 mins.


