## Recipe nof the Week

One Pot Sausage Casserole


1 tablespoon olive oil, 500 g sausages, 1 brown onion sliced, 2 cloves crushed garlic, 400g tin Cannellini beans rinsed \& drained, $2 \times 400 \mathrm{~g}$ tins diced tomato, $1 / 4$ cup BBQ sauce,
1 tablespoon brown sugar, chopped parsley leaves to serve, crusty bread to serve.

Brown sausages in pan with $1 / 2$ the oil then remove. Heat remaining oil and add onion \& garlic, cook until onion has softened. Add beans, tomato, BBQ sauce \& sugar. Return sausages to pan, cover and bring to boil, reduce heat and simmer for 25 mins.
