## Healthy Chia Seed Pudding



- 6 tablespoons CHIA SEEDS
- 2 cups coconut milk, Almond Milk or Cashew Milk
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla
- 1 tablespoon maple syrup, honey or sweetener of your choice.
