more special. There are many names for me to learn - students and parents, and I'm looking forward to knowing them all! If you haven't done so already, please come in and introduce yourself to me, this will help me learn your name.

Our school theme for 2020 is **Growing Our Respect**.

This focus was in collaboration with the staff and when we look closely at the words, I believe it has meaning for every single one of us, whether we are a staff member, a student, a parent, a community member or a school council member. We are at different points and levels of respect and we have the opportunity to grow and develop respect in our lives and in our relationships with others.

This will be the school community's focus for the year where at different points in time, we will share in the meaning behind the theme.

Staff had good opportunity to regroup during '0' week, the week preceding the return of students. During the first day together, our focus was on our purpose at Crossways Lutheran School. Staff members had opportunities to reflect and respond to a variety of activities which assisted each person to develop their own purpose statement. We began the day with worship led by our Chaplain, Tim Steeles, where God's purpose for us was the focus. One of the whole school methodologies we are implementing this year is called VCOP & Big Write. Teachers and LSO's participated in a day long workshop during '0' week where the key elements of VCOP were introduced as a way of improving student's writing. Remote School Attendance Strategy RSAS

Last week, Terena and I met with representatives from RSAS and the Youth Hub. It was a great opportunity for me to meet Nirelle Ware (RSAS Coordinator), Jess Gray and Peter Jericho (Youth hub Coordinator) and learn about their roles and the strategies they are using to encourage students to attend school. The following are just some of the work/projects they are doing in our community in 2020

- RSAS to continue to pick up the school roll every morning and to visit students and their families to follow up with their absence and to support them to attend school on that day.
- Basketball program to continue every Thursdays for Middle school students.
- RSAS to continue to support students with School Uniforms on a needs basis.
- RSAS to continue to support families with School lunches on a needs basis.
- RSAS to attend Crossways Sports Day on Friday 14th Feb 2020 at 8:00am and provide breakfast for all students. RSAS to attend Crossways "Meet & Greet" on Thursday February 6th and provide a free community BBQ for all students and their families.
