I spent a few days exploring the waters around Mt Dutton and Coffin Bays with my wife, Jane, in our sail boat Windsong. Our first night on the water we had to contend with a very strong northerly and we spent a sleepless night making sure our boat was in safe water- our anchor was dragging! Even though we found a

At one stage on my watch, we almost ran aground on the other side so it had to be a very quick response to get the boat in to deeper water! We were both very grateful when first light hit and we motored our way back through very choppy waters to the safety of the boat ramp.
