

So far, this term we have used watercolour and acrylic paints. Middle school students started a new front fence project where they designed sea creatures to replace

transferring to the appropriate size, getting their work cut out by Ceduna Steel fabrications, then sealing their piece before starting their painting using exterior house paints, followed by sealing their finished piece and evaluating their work.

The Year 6/7 class went on excursion to The Ceduna Aboriginal Arts Centre where they had local artists help them use impasto in their work. It was great to be able to get the students off campus and see the wonderful work our local artists create along with getting direction and advice.
