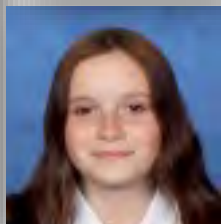
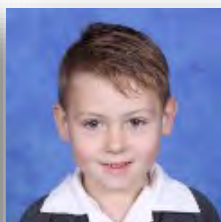

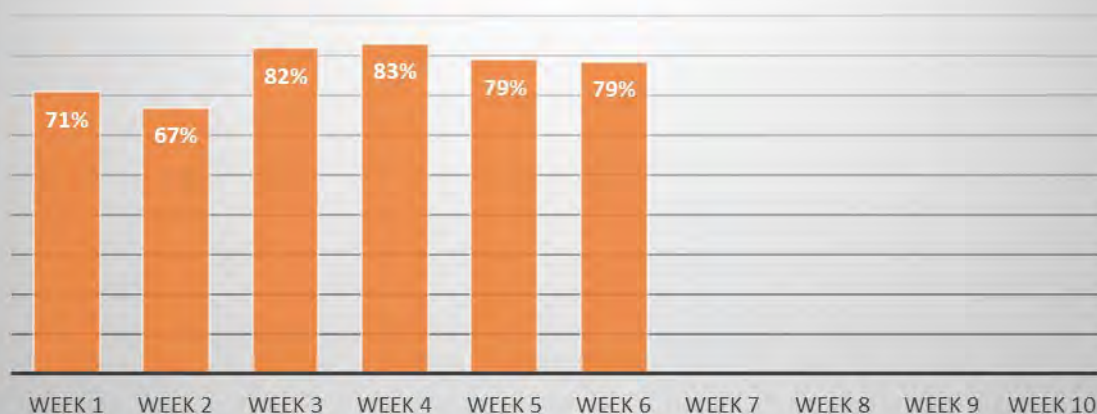

Attendance : Whole School Average

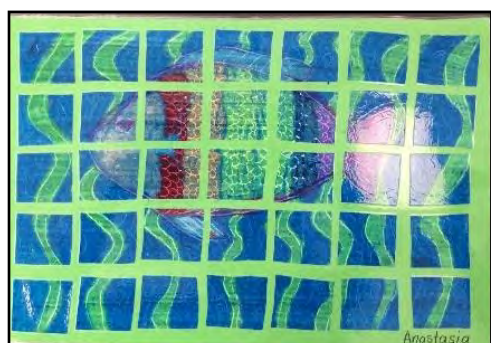
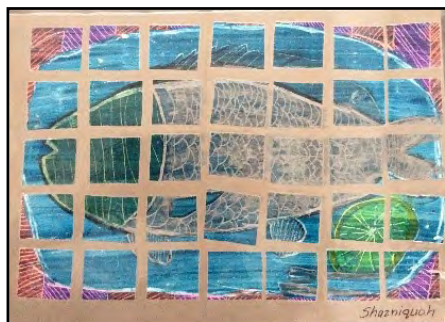

We are almost at the end of our creating stage and soon you will see new artwork on the school fence as you drive past.

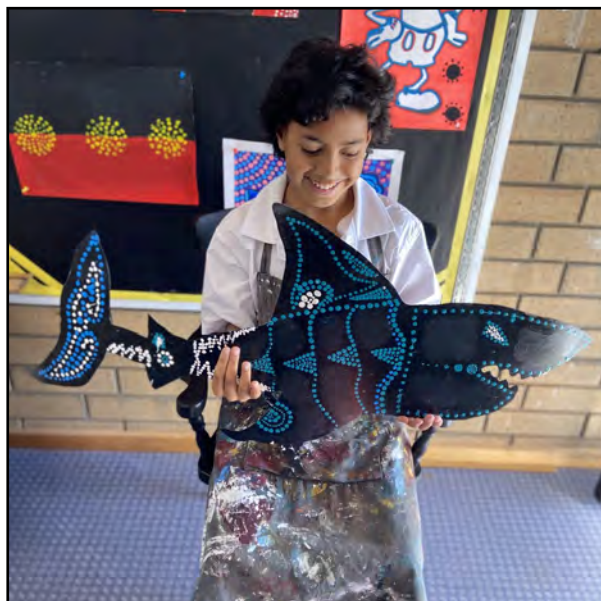
It's been a time consuming project but I think you will all agree that the completed works look great!
