The Truth

Then Jesus turned to the Jews who had claimed to believe in him. "If you stick with this, living out what I tell you, you are my disciples for sure. Then you will experience for yourselves the truth, and the truth will free you."

John 8: 31-32

This is our theme for the week – the truth.

First of all I'd like to explore the meaning

of truth in our own lives. As parents, we want our children to tell the truth, don't we? When our child does something wrong and we want to find out more about what happened, we often ask our child to please tell the truth. We want them to cut to the chase rather than going around in circles and spending a heap of time trying to figure out the truth.

We want our children to walk with us, and to trust in us, including how we provide a consequence when there needs to be one.

Similarly, Jesus wants us to walk with him, to have complete trust in him (faith!). He wants us to have a personal relationship with him so that we too can understand and know that what he says to us is the truth. And by following Jesus' way – how we ought to live and serve one another, we can have that promise of freedom.

Some of the works created in the electives will also be on show at the end of year exhibition and our students will also be


preparing and serving finger food to our guests with all choirs and our band performing over the evening.!!!!

We look forward to seeing our school and wider community at this event.








