## Principal's Word - Tony Peters



### Shelter

Psalm 91: 1-2, 9-10

*He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."*

*If you make the Most High your dwelling- even the Lord, who is my refuge- then no harm will befall you, no disaster will come near your tent.*

In times of trouble, when things are going really tough for you, where do you go for help and how do you deal and cope with whatever it is you're going through? Receiving mentoring by someone we trust can be a very useful method in dealing with our troubles.

In the verses from Psalm (see above), it says that through trust in God, we will receive rest we need to cope with our situation.

Trust God? What does this mean? To put it simply, God has promised us to give us what we need to get through difficult times. To trust in God's promises is to hand ourselves over to Him.

Something which Ms Bahr shared with us this week during staff devotions which is a good summary of what this all means- **...there's no need for you to shoulder the weight by yourself...give those burdens to God.**

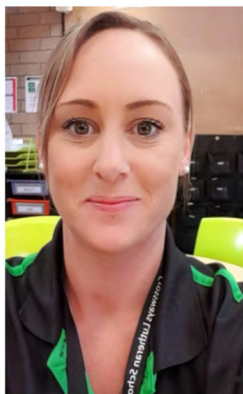

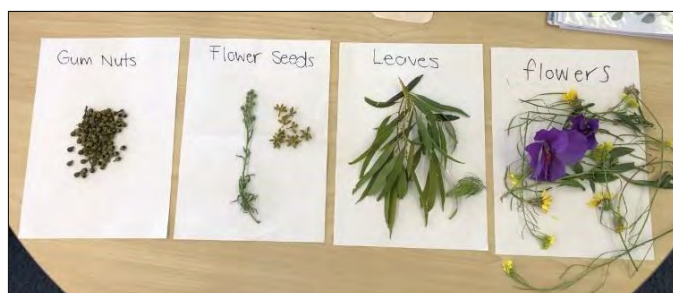
## Mr Donald Year 3/4

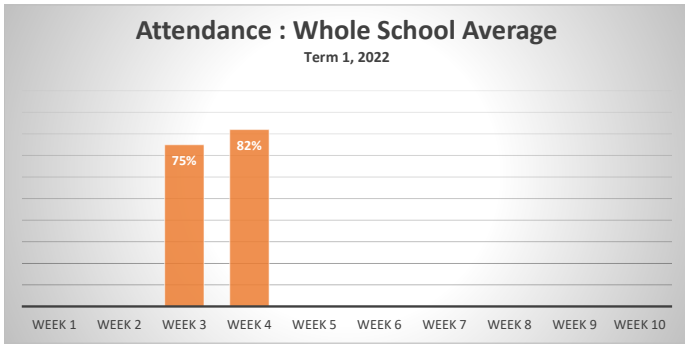
