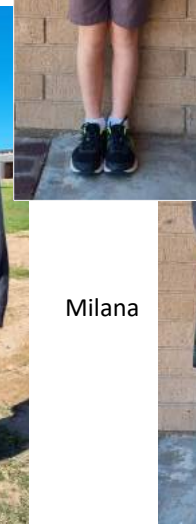

Students will be taught the correct techniques of lawn bowls accommodated by Crossway's staff members Mr. Borgas and Mr. Woodward.

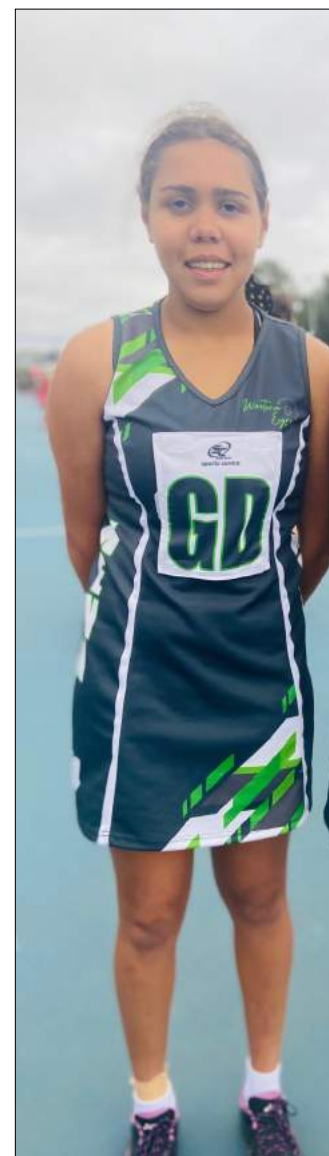
Students are to wear standard PE uniform and bring a water bottle.
