The gift of faith

The apostles said to the Lord, "Show us how to increase our faith."

The Lord answered, "If you had faith even as small as a mustard seed, you could say to this mulberry tree, 'May you be uprooted and be planted in the sea,' and it would obey you! (Luke 17:5-6)

I didn't know I had faith until I was 13

years old. It took a sudden change in life circumstances to realise that God did exist and that this faith seed was planted during the decade or so when going to church on a weekly basis. I didn't like going to church as a youngster, there wasn't much I could relate to apart from going to Sunday School which well after the service had started. In fact, on a Sunday morning I would be very quiet in the hope that my parents would sleep in and I would miss out on going to church!

Students who attend Crossways Lutheran School or any other Lutheran School will hear about God on a daily basis- this is the ethos of a Lutheran School. When a prospective family looks at Crossways as a possible learning place for their child, they also know that Christian education is a part of the curriculum. For many children, when they begin in a Lutheran School, knowledge and understanding of God is very little or nothing at all and so faith may not exist. Faith is a gift from God...it isn't something we work for or we can receive from someone else.




Above : The beautiful 'Rainbow Fish' the ELC children have had the pleasure of making this term.


