"I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my eye upon you." - Psalm 32:8 (ESV)

We make decisions every day, many are minor such as what to wear, what to eat, and that list of choices goes on endlessly. At other times the decisions we face are major and we find ourselves at a crossroad, facing decisions that hold the power to

shape our future.

In times of decision-making, we can draw great comfort from the fact that we serve a God who is both a Teacher and Counsellor. His wisdom surpasses our understanding, and His love for us is boundless.


### 'Lets chat habitat' Performance
