Caring for All

We are living in a troubled world, with recent decisions and actions that have caused grief, hardship, and loss of life. How should we respond?

As a Lutheran School, along with Christians around the world we are instructed to not only respect the rights of others but to go further in how we care for other people.

This message is echoed many times in the Bible.

Two examples of this are - Isaiah 1:17 'Learn to do right; seek justice. Defend the oppressed. Take up the cause of the fatherless; plead the case of the widow.' and Proverbs 31:8-9 'Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves, for the rights of all who are destitute. Speak up and judge fairly; defend the rights of the poor and needy.'

These verses challenge us as they are not just theoretical but are a call to action. How do we respond to events and actions which effect our community, country and the world.

Crossways Lutheran School is part of a larger Lutheran community that invests and seeks social justice not only in Australia but around the world. In Australia we have Lutheran Community Care whose Mission is "God's love in action: care, compassion and social justice for all", and around the world we have Australian Lutheran World Services. "Give to the one who asks you, and do not turn away from the one who wants to borrow from you." "In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven."


